The Lego® Serious Play™ methodology is facilitated session that promotes Thinking, Communication and Problem Solving.

The methodology can be used to bring out ideas which are inherent in individuals, making it a very suitable for adult learning process (androgogy).

Various themes such as strategy, team or personal development, creative thinking, product marketing and many more can be discussed using this method. The Facilitation Core Process is described below:



Facilitator Asks a Question



Learners Build a Model



Learners share using the model



Learners Reflect on the sharing

The process can later be extrapolated to the creation of landscapes to facilitate advance discussions and generate ideas.
